

QUALIFICATION COURSE OF FIRE

Fifty (50) round New York State DCJS qualification course of fire requires a passing score of 70 percent using factory ammunition.

- 3 Yard Line – 12 round fire in two phases:
Phase #1 – 6 rounds fired in two round increments – no time limit
Phase #2 – 6 rounds fired in 6 seconds
- 7 Yard Line- 18 rounds fired in two phases:
Phase #1 – 6 round fired in two round increments – no time limit
Phase #2 – 12 rounds fired in 25 seconds with one reload
- 15 Yard Line – 12 rounds fired in 40 seconds with one reload
- 25 Yard Line – 8 rounds fired in 40 seconds with one reload

The above qualification course was designed for 6 Shot Revolvers. 5 shot revolvers are more difficult to qualify with, **if at all possible use a 6 Shot Service Type Revolver**. Reloading devices are suggested but not required. Semi- automatic shooters are required to have a **minimum of two magazines**.
